	Towel for Washing. / Showers
	Sleep Mat
	Sleeping Bag (preferable with a hood).
	Torch and Spare Batteries
	Tea Towel.
	Plastic Bags in which to place dirty clothing.
	Personal 1 <sup>st</sup> Aid Kit
	Woolly hat,
	Whistle
	Gloves
	Plate, Bowl, Mug and Cutlery
